



- By empowering non-literate adults with essential educational skills, the initiative promotes social inclusion and strengthens the overall development of the community.

Initiative Overview

Students identify and teach non-literate parents, grandparents, and relatives essential reading, writing, and numeracy skills during the summer vacation.

Assessment

An assessment is conducted for participating parents and community members to evaluate the program's impact.



Participation

Students in Class III and above lead this educational effort.

The Satya Bharti School team briefs parents about the initiative during the Parent-Teacher Meeting (PTM) before the summer break.

Activity Module

An activity module is provided to support the teaching process.

Impact and Outcomes of Saksharta Bharti Abhiyan as of 2024

- Annually more than 10,000 parents and community members are covered.
- Given as a part of the summer vacation task, so far, the students have cumulative supported more than 77,000 non-literate adults in their families and communities to gain fundamental literacy and numeracy skills
- Parents and community members who have learned to read, write, and count have an increased sense of self-respect and dignity.



IMPACT ASSESSMENT:

SAKSHARTA BHARTI ABHIYAN



The Saksharta Bharti Abhiyan, a flagship literacy initiative by Bharti Airtel Foundation, has achieved remarkable success in empowering families through education. This initiative, driven by the students of Satya Bharti Schools, aims to enhance literacy rates among parents, especially in rural areas.

According to recent data:

Punjab

Punjab witnessed a total of 4,647 parents enrolled, with an impressive 97.53% pass rate, of which 65.42% were female.

Rajasthan

Rajasthan recorded a 96.64% pass rate from 1,637 participants, with 65.24% being female.

Haryana

Haryana showed significant progress, with 97.70% of the 2,090 parents passing, and 67.08% of them were female.

U.P.

In Uttar Pradesh, 99.04% of 939 parents successfully passed, with 64.11% being female.

Sr. Sec.

Among the Senior Secondary Schools, **3,171 parents** participated, and **99.62%** passed, with a female pass rate of **62.22%**.

In total, 12,484 parents took part in the initiative, with a collective pass rate of 98.09%. **Notably, 64.76% of the successful participants were female,** highlighting the program's contribution to gender empowerment. This program not only bridges the literacy gap but also fosters a culture of learning and empowerment in communities, reflecting the Foundation's unwavering commitment to holistic education and development.

Rajnish Sharma's Journey from Satya Bharti School to Airtel




