Bharti Foundation Ensures Rural Children Continue to Learn Even During the COVID Pandemic

The current pandemic has resulted in schools being closed since March 2020 to contain spread of the virus. Students and teachers have not been able to physically attend school. However, in this phase of social distancing, to ensure that learning continued for underprivileged children without any impediments, Bharti Foundation adapted online methods to facilitate remote learning for students.

Close to 1,000 class-wise WhatsApp groups have been created to reach out to Satya Bharti School students on their parents' mobile phones. Homework and assignments are shared over the phone based on simple tasks and activities that can be performed at home. Virtual Summer Camps, online teacher's training, telephonic Parent-Teacher Meetings are a few of the examples of how our schools have adopted new ways of working.



BHARTI FOUNDATION AT AIRTEL DELHI HALF MARATHON 2020



Due to COVID-19, the 16th edition of Airtel Delhi Half Marathon, will be held as a Virtual Run on Sunday, 29th November 2020.

SUPPORT BHARTI FOUNDATION AS A 'CARE CHAMPION' AT ADHM 2020

Care Champions are usually high profiled individuals who commit to raise a pre-specified amount for Bharti Foundation's philanthropic programs.

Individual Giving has been the strongest pillar of the philanthropy aspect of ADHM since inception. And now, more than ever, the role of individuals and the need to reach out to individuals to support, participate and fundraise/donors, is heightened.

Given below are the ways in which individuals can support and fundraise for Bharti Foundation through ADHM 2020. The different levels identified below are basis the amount of funds raised, and thereby the privileges one can get through the event.

Care Champion Silver

A Care Champion Silver (CCS) is an individual who undertakes to raise a minimum of ₹ 1.25 lakh in donations for Bharti Foundation. In order to start the fundraising journey as a CCS, one needs to register with India Cares by making a contribution of ₹ 4,000 in favour of 'India Cares Foundation', which will be included in the total minimum amount to be raised by the CCS.

Care Champion Gold

A Care Champion Gold (CCG) is an individual who undertakes to raise a minimum of ₹ 2.50 lakh in donations for Bharti Foundation. In order to start the fundraising journey as a CCG, one needs to register with India Cares by making a contribution of ₹ 7,000 in favour of 'India Cares Foundation', which will be included in the total minimum amount to be raised by the CCG.

Care Champion Diamond

A Care Champion Diamond (CCD) is an individual who undertakes to raise a minimum of ₹ 5 lakh in donations for Bharti Foundation. In order to start the fundraising journey as a CCD, one needs to register with India Cares by making a contribution of ₹ 10,000 in favour of 'India Cares Foundation', which will be included in the total minimum amount to be raised by the CCG.

Care Champion Platinum

A Care Champion Platinum (CCP) is an individual who undertakes to raise a minimum of ₹ 10 lakh in donations for Bharti Foundation. In order to start the fundraising journey as a CCP, one needs to register with India Cares by making a contribution of ₹ 13,000 in favour of 'India Cares Foundation', which will be included in the total minimum amount to be raised by the CCP.

Other Individual Fund Raisers' Category

COVID Care Fundraiser (Change of name from iCare Fundraiser for this edition)

This is an individual who sets his/her target and raises funds for Bharti Foundation to be best of his/her ability. Where the individual raises a minimum of ₹ 75,000, he/she will be recognized as a BeyondCOVID Champion.

Before remitting the amount to Bharti Foundation, an amount of ₹ 1,000 will be retained by India Cares from the total funds raised by a BeyondCOVID Champion as a donation to service the event's philanthropy aspect,

A **Millennial Champion (MI)** is an individual below the age of 21 years, who has decided to raise a minimum of ₹50,000 in donations for Bharti Foundation. The MI needs to make an upfront contribution of ₹ 2,000 in favour of 'India Cares Foundation', which will be included in the total minimum amount to be raised by the MI.

SUPPORT BHARTI FOUNDATION AT AIRTEL DELHI HALF MARATHON 2020

ENTRY FEES

Race Categories are 21km (half Marathon); 10km (Open 10K) and 5km (Great Delhi Run/ GDR).

- GDR- Great Delhi Run registration fees is Rs 299/runner and
- 21Km/Half Marathon and 10km Run Registration fees is Rs 499/runner.

An amount of ₹150 (50%) out of the Great Delhi Run entry fee will be treated as a *donation going towards a common pool managed by the Philanthropy Partner, India Cares. The funds in the common pool will be distributed, equally, amongst all participating CSOs to strengthen them during these times where their basic requirements are difficult to fund. Applicable donation receipts/80G certificates will be issued by India Cares to each entity/ individual when the registration fee is paid.

* 100% of fees paid by foreign nationals will be treated as entry fees going to the event promoter, with no part going as a donation component to India Cares. Foreign nationals cannot donate/fundraise through the registration process.

Amateur runners can choose to participate in any one of the three race categories – half marathon, 10 km and Great Delhi Run (5 km).

■ A runner needs to download and use the ADHM App (will be available for download on iOs and Android platforms soon) to record their run.

The ADHM App will allow participants to do multiple trial runs (so that one can get used to the App), however a participant can choose to do its official ADHM run, basis the run category chosen, anytime, on any one of the days from Wednesday 25th to Sunday 29th of November 2020.

This one official recorded run will form part of the respective category leaderboard.

Common Pool

Participants across run categories are encouraged to make additional donations towards charity (top-up donation) at the time of registration for any race category. Furthermore, 50% of the Great Delhi Run (5km) entry fee will be treated as a donation amount.

The above donation amounts will go to India Cares and form part of a Common Pool, to be equally distributed by India Cares amongst all CSOs registered for the Event .

Important – Foreign nationals will not be able to donate through the registration fees.

Top-up donation at the time of registering for the Event will be disenabled for a foreign national. Furthermore, 100% of Great Delhi Run (5 km) entry fees paid by foreign nationals will be treated as entry fees going to the event promoter, with no part going as a donation component to India Cares.
