



Bharti Foundation organized Spell Wizard Competition 2022- 2023 in collaboration with Education Department of Meghalaya

Meghalaya, 7 November 2022: Bharti Foundation conducted Spell Wizard Competition 2022 – 23 in Ri-Bhoi district of Meghalaya recently in collaboration with The Education Department of Meghalaya. Total 51 schools participated which comprised of 30 partnering government schools under Bharti Foundation's Satya Bharti Quality Support Program and 21 other schools from the district.

The competition was intense as it witnessed students with confidence and robust preparedness. Six rounds of competition were conducted for the upper primary classes and five rounds for lower primary classes. The jury panel comprised of:
